

## Competition rules

1. Individuals or groups of up to a maximum of six people may participate in the fifth Three Headed Monkey Award competition.
2. Entrants may submit as many games, animations and scripts as they wish, providing that they are in the final stages of development. The same individual may participate individually and/or in a group, enter one or more prizes and categories with one or more projects, except for the *Young Talent Prize*, for which participation is individual and reserved for those under 18 years old or whose 18th birthday falls during the year the competition takes place.
3. The means of presentation and deadlines are established in the call.
4. The members of the group must be the authors of the entire project, which must be original and may not have been developed, either partly or wholly, by any other person or institution that is not part of the group, and which must be the result of their knowledge and/or personal experiences.
5. This competition is amateur or indie in nature. The competition is for students (higher secondary school, vocational training, degree courses, master's degrees, etc.) and / or young developers and small recently established indie studios that have not yet published their first video game. The jury may request any information about the participant(s) of the project in relation to these rules.
6. The subject matter of the project may be freely chosen, and may not have content considered to be illegal, defamatory, sexist, racist, xenophobic, discriminatory, pornographic, or which in any way infringes the rights of third parties or is contrary to morals, public order or decency.
7. The Fundació Politècnica de Catalunya cannot be held responsible for the content of the projects presented.
8. The Fundació Politècnica de Catalunya accepts no legal responsibility for the content of the candidatures submitted to the competition.
9. There will be six prizes: the prize for the *Best Mobile Video Game*, amounting to 3,000 €; the prize for the *Best UPC Mobile Video Game*, amounting to 1,500 €; the prize for the *Best Mobile Video Game*, amounting to 1,500 €; an honourable mention for the *Best Video Game according to the Public*, with a prize of 1,500 €; a *Best Animation Prize* of 1,500 €, and finally *Young Talent Prize*, in which the winner will receive a Tablet or mobile application.
10. The prizes awarded are pre-tax sums, which are subject to any deductions of any kind that are applicable when they are awarded.
11. To be eligible for the Best UPC Video Game, at least a majority of the members of the group must be students or former students at the Polytechnic University of Catalonia, the Fundació Politècnica de Catalunya, the UPC School of Professional & Executive Development or the Fundació UPC.

12. Anyone may vote in the honourable mention according to the public, regardless of gender, education or nationality. Voting will take place on the website [www.upcvideogames.com](http://www.upcvideogames.com)

13. A project may be disqualified from the competition if the jury finds that there may have been a malicious use of the voting system for the Prize from the Public.

14. The jury will consist of several professionals from the video game and animation industry and the Fundació Politècnica de Catalunya. The members of the Jury will be announced on the website <http://www.upcvideogames.edu> before 3th April 2017. The jury's decision is final.

15. The winners and finalists agree to their names being published and disseminated by the Universitat Politècnica de Catalunya and the Fundació Politècnica de Catalunya, and like those of all the participants, they will be added to the database of those institutions for the purposes of providing information about the activities that they undertake. The consent of the legal representatives of minors participating in the competition will be necessary, and these representatives declare that they are aware of and accept the content, development and participation; signing any documents to that effect that are necessary to that end. 16. The Fundació Politècnica de Catalunya reserves the right to request documentation accrediting the status of students or former students of the Polytechnic University of Catalonia.

17. The author(s) of the participating projects will assign the rights to total or partial dissemination and image rights of the project to the Fundació Politècnica de Catalunya, for the period of 10 years.

18. The Fundació Politècnica de Catalunya reserves the right to change these rules without notice, in which case they will be published at [www.upcvideogames.com](http://www.upcvideogames.com).

19. Presentation of a candidature to the fifth *Three Headed Monkey Award* competition means that you have read and accepted these rules.

20. All matters not specifically covered in these rules shall be governed by the provisions of the call and on a secondary basis, by the decisions of the jury of the prize.

21. Acceptance of these rules entails compliance with them. If the information provided is deemed untrue, the candidature shall be automatically disqualified.
